2. Give the **genre** of the book.
*(Hint: Is it Fiction or Nonfiction? What **kind of** Fiction or Nonfiction?)*
3. What **characters** have you met?
(Hint: Who is in your story?)
4. Choose 3 characters and write a paragraph **for each one**.
(Hint: Tell at least 5 points of interest about each character and use complete sentences).
5. What is the **setting** of your story?
*(Hint: Tell both the **when** and **where** of your story.)*
6. What is the **plot** of your story?
(Hint: If friends asked you what your story is about, what would you tell them?)
7. What is the main **conflict** in your story?
(Hint: This is the biggest problem that your main character has to deal with)
8. Explain the **climax** of your story.
(Hint: This is the turning point or main event that happens in the story.)
9. What was the **resolution** to the main conflict?
(Hint: How was the problem solved?)
10. What is the **theme** of your story?
(Hint: What is the message or lesson that the author wants the readers to know or learn?)
11. What was the best part of your story?
12. Would you recommend this book to others? Why? Why not?
(Hint: Do not use "boring"!)
